# COACH'S REPORT FOR PRESENTATION EVENING 2009 -2010

## Adult Club

2009/2010 has not been as successful for the Adult Club as in previous seasons however Deeside's first team Demons did retain the North East Wales Netball League Division One title. A hairy time in the Northern League saw the team have an end of season flurry to keep them just touching mid table but it was indeed a little too frantic at times. The young Deeside Devils team had a temperamental season, mainly due to a lack of shooters in the club as a whole. However the shooters buckled down and although a bit hit & miss the team managed to keep themselves out of the bottom three - with so much potential in there it was difficult to see why some games got away from them - first Division is serious stuff team!!! Deeside Degrees had a very lean season in Division 1 and will go into the play offs in September to see if they can hold on to their first division status - team morale was low and players found it hard to sustain any momentum gained, again a lack of good shooting was the culprit. Deeside Dice in Division 3 were ready for Division 2 netball at the end of last season but once again they failed to make the top two places to make promotion a reality - Finals night for them was a repeat of last season's finals night where they won the teams that had been placed above them in the League showing that they really do have the potential to play in a higher division. The Chester Elite League turned into a bit of a disaster as team captain scratched around for players which made for poor combinations and poor results. We can only do better next season!

## Junior Club

The Deeside Junior teams however have had some outstanding results. With the exception of Deeside Dominoes U15s who have struggled to field a team this season all other teams have been at their best with some exceptional performances. Deeside Dolphins, U14s, won their Division; Deeside Dreams U13s continued to dominate their age group with Deeside Dace, U13s also working their way up the Division all season having made major improvements. Deeside Deuce U12s could not quite claim the No.1 spot but the determination is there and maybe next season? I am sure they will try! Deeside Diamonds, U11s lost a little momentum towards the end of the season to make fourth place and a place in the Finals Day Tournament & Deeside Doves, U10s had another brilliant season winning the U10 league. 
